Fun and engaging activities will target the following skills:

- ◆ **Phonological Awareness**
(rhyming, sound & syllable identification)
- ◆ **Book and Print Awareness**
- ◆ **Story Elements**
- ◆ **Event Sequencing**
- ◆ **Letter and Sound Identification**

Research shows that phonological awareness skills are significantly related to reading and spelling achievement. By targeting these early literacy skills we can help to prepare your child for reading success.

Our Program Includes:

- ◆ Pre assessment of literacy skills
- ◆ Two hour small group sessions twice per week conducted by a team of licensed professionals including a certified Speech Pathologist, Speech Pathology Assistant, and a licensed teacher!
